Two things I want you to remember as we move into August. First of all, Third Thursdays at Trinity. 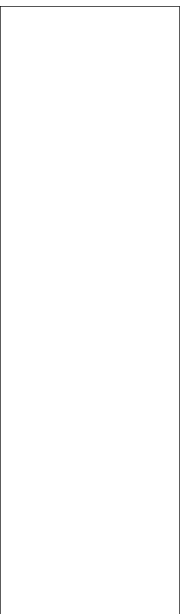
