## *From David's Desk*

### Jesus in the Park

For the last five years, I have been going to Jesus in the Park. I have watched our youth reach out to our community in ways that are as touching as they are numerous. But last year, the event went to an entirely new level.

It started with a simple phone call. Rome Action Ministries had an offer from the Atlanta Community Food Bank to deliver food for fifteen hundred families if they had a place for distribution. That prompted my friend Dawn Hayes, from Rome Action Ministries, to call Grant. "Could we distribute food at Jesus in the Park?" She wanted to know. Just a simple phone call.

We had no idea of the rains that would come the week prior. We had no idea that much of Ridgeferry Park would be flooded. We had no idea that we would not know until the last minute if we would get to use the park at all. We certainly had no idea that we would have to relocate the event within the park to accommodate the soggy ground. We had no idea that we would arrive and have no power or water. And we certainly had no idea of the thousands of people who would turn out. But with all of the unknowns, it was a great day. It was a day when we got to be the hands and feet of Jesus and literally see the "feeding of the five thousand."

It was overwhelming in more ways than one. And that brings me to this year. For more than a decade, Jesus in the Park has been a youth event. Trinity's youth, year after year have worked hard and brought it together. And they have now passed an important threshold. Jesus in the Park has done what you want every ministry to do. It has grown in such a way that it is "Changing Lives for Jesus Christ" in so many ways, it is bigger than anyone ever imagined.

And so this year, it needs to be not just a youth event, but a church-wide event. In some of our church wide events, not everyone can go. Guatemala, for example was church wide in that everyone supported the mission. But not everyone could go to Guatemala. Other church-wide events give us all the opportunity for hands-on ministry. Murphy-Harpst is a great example of that. Everyone who comes can have a part.

This year, Jesus in the Park needs to be that kind of church-wide event. At our Worship Celebration at the Forum, there will be opportunities for you to sign up and help. You will also be able to sign up on September 12<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>. And then September 26<sup>th</sup>, we will all join together at Ridgeferry Park to be the hands and feet of Christ.

If you are unsure whether or not you want to help, speak to someone who was there last year. They will tell you that you don't want to miss it. I'll be there. And I look forward to seeing you there as well.
