Worship at the Forum

This Sunday, we gather at the Forum for our annual worship service at the Forum. As you know, we will begin with a continental breakfast at 9:30 with a service at 10:30. It is a great opportunity for all of us to gather together in one service. Over the course of three services each Sunday morning there is no way for everyone to see everyone else. This service gives us an opportunity to all worship together!

Those of you who have been around Trinity for a while know that in June of 1971, Harry Alderman was appointed to be pastor here. We did not yet have the Trinity building or the Martha King building. Mobley Hall had just been dedicated. Trinity had just over five hundred members and was averaging just over 200 in worship. As the new pastor and his family were moving into the parsonage, the family included a young teenage boy named Jody. Jody would become part of Trinity's youth group and graduate from West Rome High school. And in the midst of this, seeds were planted and watered that would help to set the course for his life.

Jody went on to graduate from Emory University with a double major in Psychology and Religion. He graduated from Candler School of Theology and became an ordained elder in The United Methodist Church. Jody would go on to receive his doctorate from McCormick Seminary in Chicago.

Jody has served appointments in Covington, Austell, Stockbridge, Decatur and Roswell. He is married to the former Debye Bonner. They have three children. Katy has graduated from UGA, Kristen has graduated from LSU and Tyler is a junior at LSU. Currently, Jody serves as the senior associate pastor at Northside UMC. His responsibilities will include developing an outreach program that involves wilderness adventures, running, hiking, cycling and motorcycles. We look forward to welcoming Jody back to Trinity.

Make plans to be here Sunday as we worship together.

We are very excited that approximately 180 families are signed up for inclusion into the Trinity UMC Pictorial Directory. Photography by Colorcraft Studios will be taking place the weekend of September 11, 2010. Based on the number of families who signed up, we will most likely have four days for pictures. The dates will be Thursday, September 9 – Sunday, September 12, with the highest concentration being on Saturday, September 11.

Colorcraft will be contacting you very soon for the most convenient time for a sitting for each family. Remember to allow approximately 45 minutes for completing paperwork (both for Colorcraft and for Trinity use), to be photographed, and to view proofs. Although a purchase is not required for the free 8 x 10, you will be given the opportunity. Colorcraft accepts cash, check, Visa, Mastercard, and Discover cards.

In addition to receiving a free 8 x 10 family portrait, those families who are photographed **and** who view proofs, will also receive a free copy of the directory.

Submittals will be accepted by those families who simply cannot be available during the scheduled weekend or for homebound individuals. A personal information sheet must accompany the submittals. You may pick up a form at the Celebration at the Forum or in the church office. Deadline for submittals is Friday, September 10.
