Annual Men's Advance

Lay Speaking Course

Trinity United Methodist Church will host The District Lay Speaking Course (both basic and advanced) this March. Courses will be on Saturdays; March 6th, 13th, 20th & 27th. Attendance is required at all classes. Trinity currently has thirteen Local Church Lay Speakers and one Certified Lay Speaker. Recertification is required only every three years, but this should not stop Local Lay Speakers from advancing to Certified Lay Speakers. Lay Speaking Ministries are described in the *Discipline*; paragraphs 267; 268; and 269. In short, who needs to be, or should be, a Lay Speaker? First: Who should be... anyone who feels they have a calling to proclaim the Gospel. Second: Who needs to be...Lay Leaders, Lay Readers, Sunday School Teachers, Church Council Members, Outreach – Visitation Workers, and anyone who feels called by God.

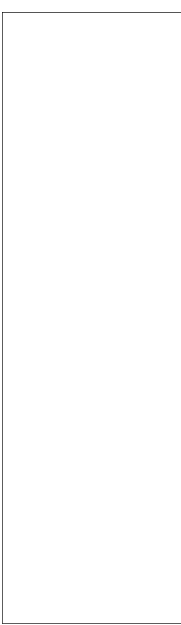
