From Our Associate Pastor:

"How Should We Do The Lord's Work?"

A minister was being shown through a large plant where they built Locomotives. The guide pointed to one particular locomotive and said, "This locomotive is the last word in engine building. It is a mighty thing if three things are in order. 1.) It must have power generated by internal combustion of crude oil. 2.) It must be on the rails, because its own power would bring destruction if it is derailed. 3.) It must have a good engineer for it will run efficiently only when handled in the proper way.

That is just like a Christian. We are powerful and useful only when we are filled with God; when we walk in His way; and when we are utterly under the control of the Holy Spirit.

Notice what Jesus said to the church after His resurrection and before His ascension in Matthew 28: 18-20- -there is no source of power for God's people for preaching, teaching, witnessing or anything else, except Jesus Christ Himself. Apart from Jesus Christ anything else is of our own flesh. In Acts 1: 8 the Greek says it this way, "you shall receive power; **then** you shall be witnesses." Look at the order: **after** the Holy Spirit came, they could be effective witnesses. When we are converted, we receive an indwelling of the Holy Spirit. BUT there is a difference in an indwelling and the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

Christians today need to follow the order and be filled with The Spirit in order for the work and witness to be more effective. That is how we should we do the Lord's work.

Changing Lives

From your Trinity email person: In a sermon recently, David asked, "Why do people need this church?"

Four years ago, on July 2, we received a phone call saying that Andrew, our oldest son, then 26 years old, had suffered a major, brain-stem stroke. He was serving as a missionary to inner-city youth in Los Angeles, so he was taken to a UCLA teaching hospital, where he fought for his life, in ICU for 10 days, and in the hospital for 7 1/2 weeks. Then he spent 3 weeks at an in-patient rehab facility.

Over those 10+ weeks, Trinity was a life-line for us, from across a continent. Our church family prayed for us, gave us frequent flyer miles and buddy passes, sent us cards of encouragement and messages on Andrew's caringbridge site, called and listened patiently to medical details and scenarios and prayed, again and again, for situations that probably made little sense to those of you at such a distance.

I will never forget the day a stressed-out ICU nurse was unkind to Andrew and had me in tears. I called and asked for prayer for a change of heart in me toward that woman, and a change in her heart toward Andrew. In minutes, the nurse got a phone call from home that required that she leave the hospital for the rest of the day. Rather than a change in heart, God decided to make a change of nurses. A VERY quickly answered prayer!

God arranged for Wynn, Debbie, Chelsey, Wes, Winfred and Sheila Jones and Pat and Sybil Parker to plan a trip out to California. The trip had been planned for months; they had no way of knowing in advance that when they arrived in L.A., as scheduled, that would be the day Andrew's ventilator tube was taken out, and he was moved from ICU

into a step-down unit. That day he was able to talk for the first time since his stroke, and we could hear his voice again, and know that he had not lost his ability to speak. Words cannot describe how desperately we needed friendly, familiar faces on that day, to share our joy.

A week later, Amanda Crosby Moncus (a former Trinity yute) brought her new husband Chris to visit us, from their home in Las Vegas - a four hour drive from L.A.. Before they left to head home, we heard Andrew, his voice clear and coherent, pray over Amanda and Chris's marriage. Again, a tremendous blessing!

Why do people need a church like Trinity? Because you do not know what tomorrow holds. Tomorrow, your world may turn upside down and you may need the love and support of a church that knows how to pray and how to be the hands and feet of Jesus to the people around them.

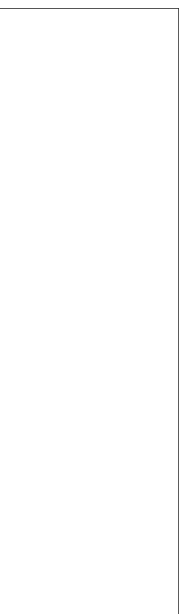
