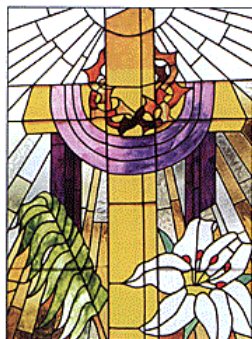
## Youth Events
