## Changing Lives for Jesus Christ

I often wonder just how many lives are touched through Trinity's ministry. There are the people in Guatemala, of course. And the thousands fed through Jesus in the Park. There are the children at Murphy Harpst and the people who come to the Community Kitchen. There is PALS and there are all of the local ministries we support, not to mention the global outreach of The United Methodist Church.

Of course, it is impossible to know. How many people drive by the Live Nativity every year? We will probably never know. Last week, some people tried to keep a count of the number of people who drove by the Living Last Supper. This was our sixth year of this outreach ministry. The people counting estimate 14,000 people saw the Living Last Supper. 14,000! Of course there is a difference between seeing something and being touched by it. How many were touched by it? We have no way to know. But I do know of one.

On Monday morning, I got an email that you need to read...

*Good Morning, Pastor!*

*I just wanted to share with you the impact your church's re-creation of the Lord's Supper had on my grandson. He is three, his father is a pastor in a church not far from Rome.*

*On Friday, my son had to bring the three year olds brother to the doctor. As they headed towards the Specialty Hospital, where their mother works, they passed by your church with the table and food and the people dressed as in that day. All of a sudden the three year old shouted, "There was God!"*

*My son questioned, "What did He look like?"*

*"He looked like Jesus," was his reply.*

*As my son closed his Sunday evening service, he shared this story with our congregation. His ending question was, "How has Jesus shown Himself alive to you?" And he continued by saying, "If I asked anyone here if you have seen God, you would say no. And if any of you here have seen Jesus, you would say no. But to a three-year-old little boy in this congregation, he would raise his hand and say yes."*

*Through the ministry of your church family, my grandson saw God.*

What a great testimony to the faithfulness of the Body of Christ that we call Trinity United Methodist Church! Thank God for a church that is committed to "Changing Lives for Jesus Christ".
