From David's Desk:

What I Was Going to Say...

If you were here on Sunday you know that we concluded our series on 3 Questions. We closed out talking about why people need Trinity. We talked about our church's mission of "Changing lives for Jesus Christ." At our early service, I stood up to preach with between thirty-five and forty minutes left in the service. I finished preaching a little over twenty minutes later, and we still had plenty of time left. I stopped Kam during the closing hymn to invite people to consider how lives had been changed and to share those stories. It was an unplanned powerful moment. In other words... God at work.

As I told people to sit after the hymn, the first person just stayed on their feet ready to share. The people at 8:30 heard powerful stories of how lives have been changed. At 9:45, we did not have as much time, but I did share what had happened. During the closing hymn, we had someone come forward who wanted to share. At 11, we had a few moments and heard from a couple of more people. Each and every story was powerful. What I would find later is that this was happening not just in worship. It seems that all over the church, that conversation continued. There was a lot of... "What I was going to say was..." It happened in Sunday school classes, hallways, the parking lot and over lunch. My wife at lunch said, "What I was going to say was how Pam Mixon has changed Jays' life by interpreting worship services for him." She is exactly right. (Thanks, Pam.) And there are countless stories people have of how lives have been changed at Trinity.

The average child in the city has 5.6 years of schooling while indigenous children in rural areas have only an average of 2.2 years of schooling. Most do not have access to education. Factors which have influenced access are geographic, linguistic, economic and social inequalities. Education is critical to building economic growth for a county and a fundamental for social development and the formation of good citizens. Take the "one " challenge! 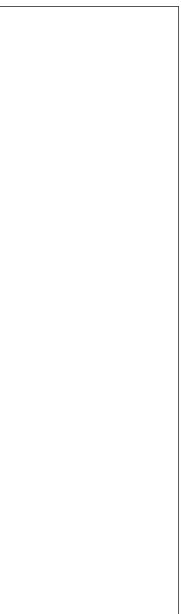
