From David's Desk:

Welcome to our new Director of Children and Family Ministries

As you know, Jennifer Goble tendered her resignation last month. Jennifer has been in ministry with us this past year. And while we have been thrilled to have her, she has realized that her heart is in the classroom. She is currently looking for an elementary school teaching position. The good news for us is that she, Trey and James will stay active at Trinity and she will remain involved in children's ministry. We look forward to that and keep her in our prayers as she looks for a teaching job.

That left an opening for our Staff-Parish Relations Committee. Last year, we posted the job and received applications. Amy Cavin had held the job for nine years and we very much believed we needed to advertise the job. With some input from Jennifer, we decided this year to take another approach. We began the process by discussing people within the church we thought would be good choices for us. One name topped our list. There was one minor issue: that person already had a very good job here in town. As a matter of fact, that person was a Senior Vice President here in town. Would she consider leaving that to work with Trinity's children?

We approached her at the end of last month and told her that we were interested in her prayerfully considering the job. She said that for some time, God has been placing a desire on her heart to invest more of her time in ministry with children. She was more than willing to pray about this opportunity. After taking time to pray, she expressed strong interest, but also reservations. The reservations were understandable. It would be a major life change for her and her family. She informed her boss she was considering our offer. Wednesday of last week, she stepped out on faith and told her boss she would accept our offer. On Friday, they asked her to stay on part-time and work from home, which she readily agreed to do.

In order to help the transition with her current employer, she will continue full-time there until mid July. Prior to that, she will be working on her own time to make sure we are ready for a smooth transition and to ensure we are ready for promotion Sunday this August. Jennifer has graciously agreed to work through Sunday, July 17th. On the morning of the 18th, our new Director of Children and Family Ministries will officially begin work.
