Dumfries, Virginia Thursday, with a performance that Night.

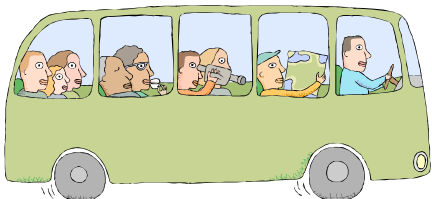
The Outer Banks Friday and Saturday with a tour of Kitty Hawk and a performance that night.

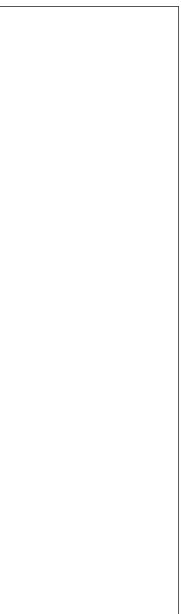
