Mother's Day

The first round of storms hit Floyd County on Wednesday morning, April 27th. Many people were affected. Many of you spent Wednesday without power. Many of you spent Wednesday working to help others. Many of you took calls all day. That was certainly true for me. But three calls stood out to me. One was from a son concerned for his mother. He had not heard from her and could not get to her. Could anyone make sure she was okay? The second was from a daughter concerned for her mother. It was a similar conversation. The third one came from my own mother. She wanted to know if I was alright. Was my family alright?

So on the one hand, you have people concerned about their mothers. And on the other, you have my mother checking in. Such was the concern for and from mothers on the day the storms hit. But you know and I know that expressions such as this happen every day. We are all who we are because of our mothers. As we prepare to celebrate Mother's Day, we remember the impact of important women in our lives. And we remember how the scriptures describe such a woman. Proverbs 31 says,
