About Guatemala

Food production in Guatemala does not meet internal needs. Local production of the 3 main staple crops or beans, rice and maize reaches about only 60% of the population. The rural poor depend on agriculture for their livelihoods in Guatemala. Water born diseases such as diarrhea, hepatitis, typhoid and cholera are the result of consuming contaminated water. Children are especially are effected by problems of basic sanitation. Improper sewage disposal, improper management of household and industrial waste and stagnant gray water are ongoing sanitation issues. Take the "one " challenge! Give the cost of one bottle of water per day, One fast food meal per week for 2 months for the Guatemala mission. One person can make a difference! One person can Change lives for Jesus Christ!

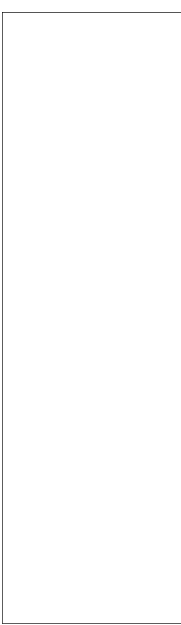
