In the past, Trinity has had several visitation programs, but I would like to tell you about the one we have now—LRE. As best as I can remember, this program started about 14 or 15 years ago and is still going strong. The teams in the evening LRE visit new members and take them a packet of information. They see visitors, those with new babies, those in the hospital and members who have not attended for a while to let them know they are missed. The afternoon team visits the elderly in assisted living and nursing homes and the home bound. Some are members and others are friends who have been referred to us. We take them the Upper Room devotionals, cd's of the services, bulletins and newsletters. One lady loans out the cd's to her friends so they can enjoy Trinity services. We also have a group that takes communion to those who request it. Unless you have been in LRE, you cannot know what a great feeling it is as others are so glad to see you coming to visit.
