## **Jesus in the Park 2009**

We are EXCITED to remind everyone that Jesus in the Park will be held this Sunday, September 27, from noon until 7 pm at Rome's Ridgeferry Park.

For more than a decade, the Trinity Youth Ministry has organized this event as an outreach across the Northwest Georgia community, and with the great support of our entire congregation and many local community sponsors, we are happy to say that our "Jesus Party" is ready to go for another year!

At Jesus in the Park, attendees will enjoy an "admission free" day of live music, fun inflatable's, face painting, carnival-style games, free food from the concession stand, and a community-wide service of Holy Communion at the end of the day.

New for this year, we are also offering a community-services fair, where local outreach and need-based organizations and leaders will be on-hand to provide information and counseling services for anyone in need of assistance. And in addition to the community-services fair, we are also partnering with Rome Action Ministries and the Atlanta Food Bank to bring in two tractor-trailer loads of free food to be distributed at the event, estimated to be enough food to provide for 1500 families! This is in addition to the free food we will be providing at the concession stand throughout the day!

Will you join us for Jesus in the Park? Will you help spread the word throughout our community about Jesus in the Park, especially in those areas where it is needed the most? Will you pray for Jesus in the Park? Will you BE Jesus in the Park?
